# • Eligibility Requirements

- US Citizen or US permanent resident
- Undergraduate students enrolled in accredited four year colleges in the US, Puerto Rico, or other US territories
- Sophomores, juniors, or non-graduating seniors
- Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or greater
- Interest in pursuing a Ph.D. or M.D.-Ph.D.

#### • Application Process

- o Each host institution has their own application process
- o Most application deadlines are early to mid-February
- Finalist will be selected and notified by late March.
