

The Amgen Scholars US Program

- **Purpose**
 - Every year, the Amgen Scholars U.S. Program provides hundreds of selected undergraduate students with the opportunity to engage in a hands-on research experience at many of the nation's premier educational institutions. Currently, 10 institutions in the U.S. host the summer research program. The Amgen Foundation has committed more than \$50 million over twelve years to the global Amgen Scholars Program to make this opportunity possible for thousands of students.
- **Eligibility Requirements**
 - US Citizen or US permanent resident
 - Undergraduate students enrolled in accredited four year colleges in the US, Puerto Rico, or other US territories
 - Sophomores, juniors, or non-graduating seniors
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or greater
 - Interest in pursuing a Ph.D. or M.D.-Ph.D.
- **Application Process**
 - Each host institution has their own application process
 - Most application deadlines are early to mid-February
 - Finalist will be selected and notified by late March.
