• Eligibility Requirements

- o Full-time student or recent graduate from universities in the following countries:
 - Bosnia
 - Herzegovina
 - Denmark
 - France
 - Germany
 - Greece
 - The Netherlands
 - Poland
 - Ukraine
 - United States
- o A citizen of any of the above countries studying at any university in any country

• Application Process

- Submit application once it opens in late fall
- o Panel or Humanity in Action Board members and Senior Fellows review applications and selects finalist pool.
- Selection Committee reads and evaluates finalist options
- Selections based off second reading of application and interview
