

# The Knight-Hennessy Scholars

- **Purpose**
  - The Knight-Hennessy Scholars program will annually identify a group of up to 100 high-achieving students from around the world with demonstrated leadership and civic commitment to receive full funding to pursue a wide-ranging graduate education at Stanford, with the goal of developing a new generation of global leaders. The Knight-Hennessy Scholars is the largest fully endowed scholars program in the world.
- **Eligibility Requirements**
  - A citizen from any country
  - Applying to enroll in any full-time graduate degree program at Stanford
  - You must apply during your final year of your first degree or within 6 years of earning your first degree
- **Application Process**
  - Students can expect the following requirements throughout the process:
    - Background information
    - Transcripts
    - Test scores, if available and required by departments
    - Resume
    - Recommendation Letters
    - Short answers and essays
    - Video
  - Submit application by mid-October
  - Apply to the graduate program you wish to pursue by mid-Fall
  - Selection of 100 finalists by mid-February
  - Final class selection made mid-March
