Their direct engagement with Britain through its best academic programs contributes to their ultimate personal success.

• Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be citizens of the United States of America
- Student must hold their first undergraduate degree from an accredited four-year college or university in the United States
- Student must have obtained a grade point average of not less than 3.7 on their undergraduate degree
- o Student should not have studied for, or hold a degree from a British University

Selection Process

o Applications are reviewed and recipients will be notified after interviews are conducted, no later than December.

• Application Process

- Students can expect the following requirements on the application:
 - Letter of endorsement from ECU
 - Online application
 - Transcripts for all college coursework
 - Four letters of recommendation that speak to your leadership, public service and academic achievements.
