- **Purpose**
 - The purpose of the Fellowship is to provide opportunities for continuing generations of able and accomplished New Americans to achieve leadership in their chosen fields and to partake of the American dream. The program was established in recognition of the contributions New Americans have made to American life and in gratitude for the opportunities the United States afforded the founders of the Fellowship, Paul & Daisy Soros.
- **Eligibility Requirements**
 - New American Status (Born in the US, Naturalized Citizen, Green Card, Adopted, DACA)
 - Enrolled or expected to be enrolled in a full time graduate program at a US university
 - Must be under the age of 31
- **Application Process**
 - Submit application mid to late October
 - Submit the following items
 - Confirmation of eligibility
 - Personal and contact information
 - Higher education history
 - Graduate program for which support is sought
 - Resume
 - Two essays
 - Transcripts
 - Recommendations (3 required, up to 5 accepted)
 - Standardized test scores
