# **SMART Scholarship for Service Program**

## Purpose

The SMART Program, part of the Department of Defense (DoD) science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) portfolio, provides STEM students with the tools needed to pursue higher education and begin a rewarding career with the DoD. With a full scholarship, students pursuing STEM degrees will be able to focus on complex research to further the DoD's mission and create a lasting impact. Summer internships are performed at DoD facilities alongside scientists and engineers; these experiences prepare scholars for full-time employment and get them accustomed to working with the DoD. SMART is a one-for-one commitment; for every year of degree funding, the scholar commits to working for a year with the DoD as a civilian employee.

## • Eligibility Requirements

- o a citizen of the United States, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, or United Kingdom at time of application,
- 18 years of age or older as of August 1
- requesting at least 1 year of degree funding prior to graduation (which starts at the program start date),
- o able to complete at least one summer internship (multi-year scholars only)
- o willing to accept post-graduation employment with the DoD,
- o a student in good standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale,
- o pursuing a technical undergraduate or graduate degree in one of the 21 STEM disciplines listed below,
- able to produce a fall 2023 college transcript from a regionally accredited US college or university, OR be pursuing a graduate degree at a regionally accredited US college or university.

# <u>Undergraduate applicants</u>

- Must be currently enrolled at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university
- Must be able to produce a fall 2023 (or earlier) college transcript at the end of the term
- AP coursework is not considered college credit

#### Graduate applicants

- Can be either currently enrolled in a regionally accredited U.S. college or university or awaiting notification of admission
- If awaiting admission, you must be accepted for entrance in the fall 2024 term

#### Selection Process

Applications are reviewed and award letters will be granted the following spring.

O Applicants open August and then must click the "Submit Application" button before December 1 at 5:00 PM EST for their applications to be considered.
