SMART Scholarship for Service Program

- Purpose
 - The SMART Program, part of the Department of Defense (DoD) science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) portfolio, provides STEM students with the tools needed to pursue higher education and begin a rewarding career with the DoD. With a full scholarship, students pursuing STEM degrees will be able to focus on complex research to further the DoD's mission and create a lasting impact. Summer internships are performed at DoD facilities alongside scientists and engineers; these experiences prepare scholars for full-time employment and get them accustomed to working with the DoD. SMART is a one-for-one commitment; for every year of degree funding, the scholar commits to working for a year with the DoD as a civilian employee.

• Eligibility Requirements

- a citizen of the United States, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, or United Kingdom at time of application,
- 18 years of age or older as of August 1
- requesting at least 1 year of degree funding prior to graduation (which starts at the program start date),
- able to complete at least one summer internship (multi-year scholars only)
- willing to accept post-graduation employment with the DoD,
- o a student in good standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale,
- pursuing a technical undergraduate or graduate degree in one of the 21 STEM disciplines listed below,
- able to produce a fall 2024 college transcript from a regionally accredited US college or university, OR be pursuing a graduate degree at a regionally accredited US college or university.
- Undergraduate applicants
 - Must be currently enrolled at a regionally accredited U.S. college or university
 - Must be able to produce a fall 2024 (or earlier) college transcript at the end of the term
 - AP coursework is not considered college credit
- Graduate applicants
 - Can be either currently enrolled in a regionally accredited U.S. college or university or awaiting notification of admission
 - If awaiting admission, you must be accepted for entrance in the fall 2025 term
- Selection Process
 - Applications are reviewed and award letters will be granted the following spring.
- Application Process
 - Applicants open August and then must click the "Submit Application" button before the first Friday in December at 5:00 PM EST for their applications to be considered.
